Sending Money to the Settlements

A New York Times review of public records identified at least 40 American groups that have collected hundreds of millions of dollars in tax-deductible gifts over the past decade to help Jews strengthen settlements and outposts in the Israeli-occupied territories. Settlements and outposts labeled in bold on this map are known to have received financing from American groups.

Since 2004, the group has sent nearly \$1.2 million to communities in the Shomron region, **1** some of which are unauthorized outposts.

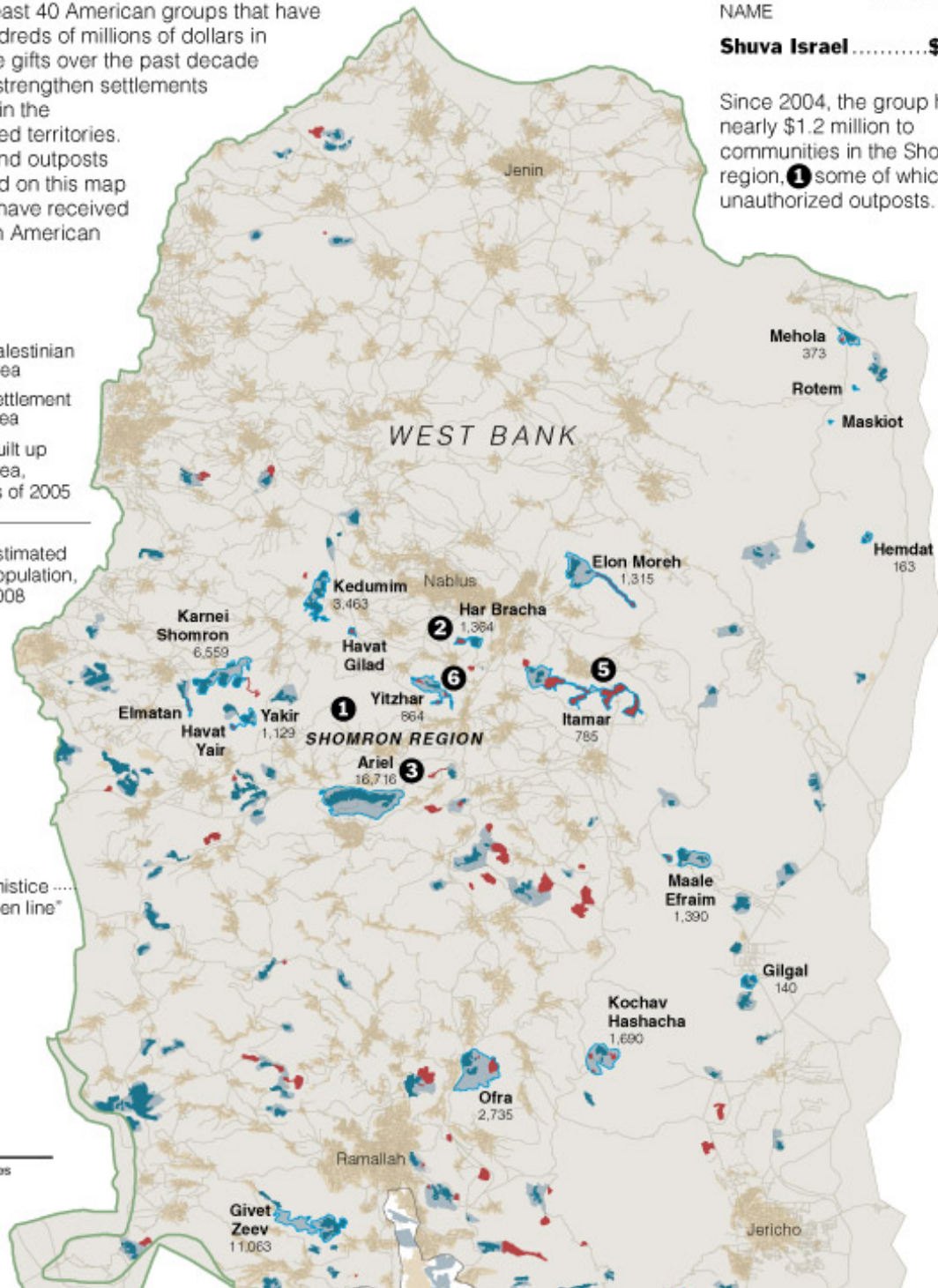

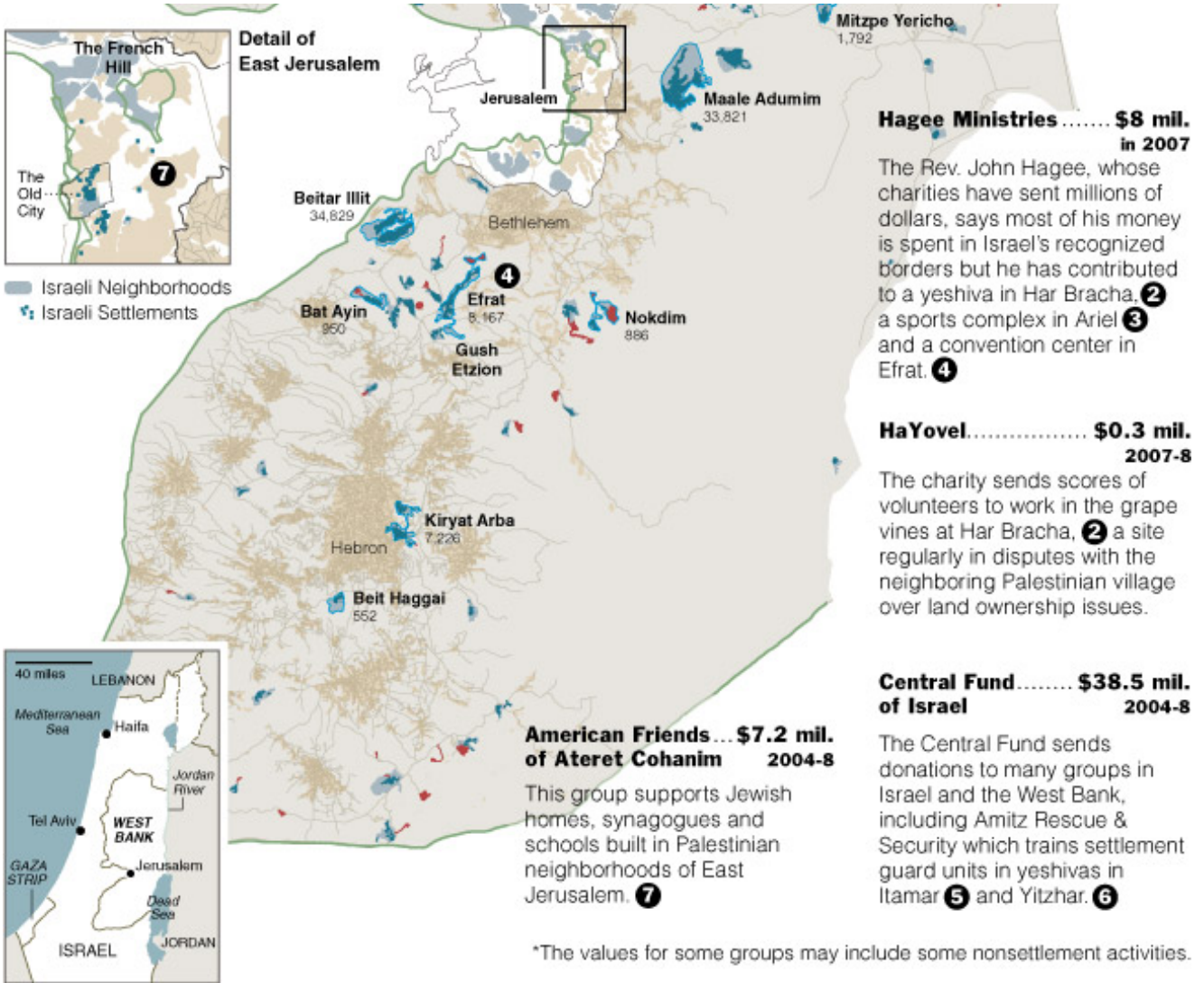
